

1990s – 2004	Community advocacy (Northeast Partnership & Chamber)
November 2004	Community-wide organizational breakfast (100 attendees) Community Advisory Councils <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Partnership2. Programs3. Design
February 2005	Passage of \$450m bond FAILED (\$125m for NLC)
November 2005	Passage of \$450m bond PASSED (\$125m for NLC)
April 2006	Community “Name the College” contest
November 2006	Mission Retreat
January 2007	ACCD Board of Trustees approve formation of new college
August 2008	4,000 students begin classes in the five (5) new buildings at the NLC permanent site
August 2009	5,200 students begin classes as an additional four (4) buildings are opened – plus 125 high school students begin at the Judson ISD Early College Academy (JECA)
August 2010	6,511 students enroll and begin classes in the nine-building, fully-completed Northeast Lakeview College




